

NOTICE OF ELECTIONS

Section 1-5-205(1)(a)-(1)(d), C.R.S.
Section 1-7.5-107(2.5)(a)(b), C.R.S.

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, and particularly, to the electors of the Rampart Range Metropolitan District Nos. 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9 (the “Districts”) of the City of Lone Tree, Douglas County, Colorado.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that elections will be held on May 8, 2012, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. regarding the questions of the boards of directors and the submission of propositions of issuing general obligation bonds or creating other general obligation indebtedness or any questions necessary to implement the provisions of Article X, Section 20, of the Colorado Constitution as applied to the Districts.

The elections are being conducted as mail ballot elections by the Designated Election Official, Denise Denslow, c/o CliftonLarsonAllen LLP, 8390 E. Crescent Parkway, Suite 500, Greenwood Village, Colorado 80111, telephone number (303) 779-4525. The place of deposit for mail ballots and walk-in polling place for voting at the elections will be at said office.

The walk-in polling place shall be open Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. beginning April 13, 2012, and from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the date of the elections.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that an eligible elector of said Districts for the purpose of said election is a person registered to vote pursuant to the “Colorado Uniform Election Code of 1992”; and (i) who has been a resident of the Districts for not less than thirty (30) days, or (ii) who, or whose spouse, owns taxable real or personal property within the Districts, whether said person resides within the Districts or not. A person who is obligated to pay taxes under a contract to purchase taxable property within the Districts shall be considered an owner of taxable property for the purpose of qualifying as an eligible elector.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that applications for mail-in voter ballots may be filed with the Designated Election Official at the address set forth above no later than the close of business on the 7th day prior to the elections if such applicant wishes to receive same by mail, or until the close of business on the Friday immediately preceding the elections if the applicant applies in person at the above address. Return of mail-in voter ballots and replacement ballots may be received by the Designated Election Official at the above address, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. beginning on April 13, 2012, until the day prior to the elections, or between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on the date of the elections.
