#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly approved, and the Governor on May 2, 2014 signed House Bill 14-1193, with an effective date of July 1, 2014; and

WHEREAS, such Bill added Section 24-72-205(6)(a) concerning research and retrieval fees for public records; and

WHEREAS, under such statute, a custodian of records may impose a fee in response to a request for the research and retrieval of public records only if the custodian has, prior to the date of receiving the request, either posted on the custodian's website or otherwise

published a written policy that specifies the applicable conditions concerning the research and retrieval of public records by the custodian, including the amount of any current fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMPARK BUSINESS CAMPUS METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, that, effective July 1, 2014:
