<b>Date of the next regular special district election of board members</b>	May 6, 2014
<b>Procedure and timing to submit a self-nomination form for election to the Board(s) pursuant to § 32-1-804.3, C.R.S. :</b> Pursuant to §§ 32-1-804.3 (1) and (5), C.R.S. any person interested in being a candidate for the Board must submit a self-nomination and acceptance form signed by the candidate and by a registered elector of the District as a witness to the candidate. On the date of signing the self-nomination form, the person desiring to serve on the Board must be an eligible elector of the District. The form or letter must be filed not less than Sixty-Seven (67) days before the date of the next regular special district election. The form is filed with the Designated Election Official, or if none has been designated, the presiding officer or the secretary of the District at the address as disclosed in Question No. 1 above. This form may be obtained by contacting the District's general counsel at (303) 858-1800. In place of the form, the candidate may submit a letter signed by the candidate and a registered elector of the District as witness to the signature of the candidate. Both the form and letter must state the following information: (1) name of the special district; (2) director office sought; (3) term of office sought; (4) date of the election; (5) full name of the candidate as it is to appear on the ballot. A form that is not sufficient may be amended once any time prior to 3:00 pm on the 67th day before the election.	
<b>Information regarding permanent mail-in voter ("PMIV") status</b>	An application to request permanent mail-in voter ("PMIV") status may be obtained from the Douglas County Clerk and Recorder or on-line from the Colorado Secretary of State <a href="http://www.sos.state.co.us">www.sos.state.co.us</a> . Upon completion of the application, the application may be returned to the Douglas County Clerk and Recorder.
