- b) Include notice as a prominent part of a newsletter, annual report, billing insert, billing statement, letter, voter information card or other notice of election, or other informational mailing sent by the district to the eligible electors;
- c) Post notice on district's official website (Note: You must also provide the Division of Local Government (<http://www.colorado.gov/cs/Satellite/DOLA-Main/CBON/1251592910248>) with the address of your district's website to establish a link on the DLG's site);
