This matter comes before the Court, pursuant to § 32-1-707, C.R.S., on a Petition for Dissolution (the "Petition") of The Canyons Metropolitan District No. 6 and Submission of Offer of Proof and Motion for Order Dissolving (the "Motion") The Canyons Metropolitan District No. 6 (the "District"). On February 5, 2025 at 1:30 p.m. a hearing was held on the Petition and the Motion. This Court, being fully advised on the premises and there being no objection by any person, hereby FINDS AND ORDERS as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to § 32-1-707(1)(b)(I), C.R.S., the District has no financial obligations or outstanding bonds.
- 2. Pursuant to § 32-1-707(1)(b)(III), C.R.S., the District lies wholly within the corporate limits of the City of Castle Pines and the District provides no services or facilities to the property located within the District's boundaries.
- 3. The District's Board of Directors and the City of Castle Pines City Council have both adopted resolutions consenting to the dissolution of the District.
- 4. Pursuant to § 32-1-704(3)(b), C.R.S., The Canyons Metropolitan District No. 6 shall be and hereby is dissolved and no election shall be require to effectuate the dissolution.

- 5. Pursuant to § 32-1-707(5), C.R.S., a certified copy of this Order for Dissolution shall be filed with the Douglas County Clerk and Recorder and with the Division of Local Government by the attorneys for the Petitioners. The boundary map of the property located within the District's boundaries is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.
- 6. Pursuant to § 32-1-707(6), C.R.S., this Order of Dissolution shall be final and conclusive against all persons; except that an action may be instituted by the State of Colorado in the nature of quo warranto commenced within thirty-five (35) days after the Order for Dissolution is entered.
