Call to Order:	Chairman Drennen called to order the regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the E-470 Public Highway Authority.
Pledge of Allegiance:	Those present participated in reciting the pledge of allegiance.
Public Comment:	Chairman Drennen asked for comments from the public in attendance. No members of the public asked to be heard.
Consent Calendar:	Councilmember Martin moved approval of the consent calendar, comprising the April 11, 2013 meeting minutes. Commissioner Tedesco seconded the motion, which was thereafter approved unanimously by the Board of Directors.
Finance: 2012 Audit Presentation and Acceptance	Mr. Myers reported that the 2012 Audit, performed by the Authority's audit firm, KPMG, LLP, was complete and went smoothly. He noted that each Director had a hard copy included with their meeting materials and he thanked the Audit Committee of the Board, comprising Councilmember Anderson, Commissioner Conway and Commissioner Holen. He then briefed the Board about the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB) changes which required a restatement of the 2011 audited financial statements, in addition to the work for 2012. Mr. Myers then introduced Rob Filliben, Audit Partner, and Laura McCormick, Audit Manager, both of KPMG, LLP, to further discuss the audit. Mr. Filliben reviewed with the Board various elements of the audit and reported that KPMG, LLP gave a clean audit opinion, noting that his firm encountered no significant difficulties in dealing with the Authority's management in performing the audit. Mr. Filliben, among other items of note, highlighted the Authority's 1.46 debt service coverage ratio as well above the required ratio of 1.30. Councilmember Anderson commended the clarity of the audit statement and underscored the significant effort put forth by the Authority's staff as a result of the GASB changes. Commissioner Conway echoed Councilmember Anderson's comments adding his appreciation for the staff efforts. Councilmember Benson asked about GASB rules changes and comparisons year to year. Mr. Filliben indicated the need for comparison drove the restatement of the 2011 audited financial statements. Thereafter, Councilmember Martin

moved that the Board accept the December 31, 2012 and 2011 E-470 Public Highway Authority Basic Financial Statements, with Independent Auditor's Report Thereon. Councilmember Benson seconded the motion was approved unanimously by the Board of Directors.

Mr. Myers reported to the Board on the E-470 Public 2012 Annual Report Highway Authority Annual Report, also included in the meeting materials, and indicated he would be happy to answer any questions related thereto.

First Quarter Update -Mr. Koniz reviewed with the Board of Directors the First Dashboard Report Quarter Update for 2013. He reported that the 2013 budgeted debt service ratio of 1.39 was less than 2012 actual of 1.46 but well above the minimum requirement of 1.30, the traffic was up 4.9% and toll revenue was up 9.7%. These performance indicators were on pace with 2007 which was the Authority's best performance year to date. He reviewed the leakage with the Board, noting the bulk related to temporary tags.

Meeting Outcome

Colorado State Titles And Mr. Kristick reported that they were working on the vehicle registration hold criteria, legal enforceability, dollar thresholds and completion of a public relations plan. He expects to present the proposed plan to the Board of Directors for consideration and potential approval at the May 23, 2013 Board meeting.

> Councilmember Martin informed the Board that Lone Tree representatives, including Councilmember Millet, attended a Town of Parker meeting and he expected the Town Council to vote on the City of Lone Tree's affiliate membership request at the next Town Council meeting.

Executive Director's Report: Mr. McCuskey opened his remarks by noting that the annual report in the meeting packet served not just as a marketing item but was also required by the Authority's bond covenants. He reported on the status of 2013 legislation, noting the SB13-203 and HB13-1313 died in committee and HB13-1299 did not change the operation of the TLRC save for a name change. He then noted that the E-470 Transportation Safety Foundation, a 501(c)(3) entity, gave grants in 2013 to: Children's Hospital (2 grants totaling \$5,000), Laradon (\$2,500), Rampart Search and Rescue (\$2,500), Rocky Mountain Every 15 Minutes (\$2,500) and Commerce City (\$2,500). The E-470 TSF awarded \$200 grants to the following after prom programs: Aurora West College Preparatory Academy (Aurora), Brighton High School (Brighton), Eaglecrest High School (Centennial),

Grandview High School (Aurora) and Prairie View High School (Henderson). Thereafter, Mr. McCuskey reminded the Board of Directors that the annual meeting of the International Bridge, Tunnel and Turnpike Association (IBTTA) would be held in September in Vancouver and the IBTTA would hold a meeting in Denver from July 21 - 23 at the Hyatt in Downtown Denver. Finally, Mr. McCuskey reported that Danna Parker had left the Authority to take a position with the Northwest Parkway as Director of Finance and that she would be missed.

Adjournment: There being no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Drennen declared the meeting adjourned.
