ANNUAL REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019

Pursuant to §32-1-207(3)(c), C.R.S., the Town of Castle Rock, Colorado (the "Town") has requested that The Villages at Castle Rock Metropolitan District No. 9 (the "District"), submit an annual report to the Town reflecting the activity and financial events through the preceding December 31 (the "report year" or "2019").

As noted in the 2018 Annual Report to the Town, the District's Board of Directors (the "Board") was reconstituted through appointment by the Town Council on August 21, 2018, through adoption of Resolution No. 2018-072, after a period of nearly 30 years of the Board being vacated and of the District being dormant. Since that time, the Board has worked on bringing the District current and assessing the outstanding obligations and needs of the District and its taxpayers.

For the year ending December 31, 2019, the District makes the following report:

A. A narrative summary of the progress of the District in implementing its service plan for the report year;

No public improvements were constructed by the District during the report year.

B. Except when an exemption from audit has been granted for the report year under the Local Government Audit Law, the audited financial statements of the District for the report year including a statement of financial condition (i.e. balance sheet) as of December 31 of the report year and a statement of operations (i.e. revenues and expenditures) for the report year;

The 2019 Application for Exemption from Audit and a letter from the State Auditor accepting the audit exemption application are attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

No capital expenditures were incurred by the District in 2019 and none are currently proposed.

The primary sources of revenue for the District in 2020 will be property taxes and developer advances. The District intends to impose an 87.842 mill levy on the property within the District for 2020, which will be dedicated to the General Fund.
