THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, COLORADO

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DOUGLAS COUNTY CULTURAL COUNCIL'S RECOMMENDATION FOR SCFD TIER III FUNDING FOR 2014-2015

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Cultural Council was appointed by the Board of County Commissioners to determine the distribution of Tier III sales tax proceeds as provided for in the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District Act; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the Douglas County Cultural Council are (1) to direct resources to qualifying organizations which are accessible to, and whose scientific and cultural services benefit, residents of Douglas County; and (2) to promote long-term development and diversity of the scientific and cultural resources available to residents of Douglas County; and

WHEREAS, proceeds are required by statute to be distributed to organizations qualified as not-for-profit under IRC Section 501(c)(3), or agencies of local government whose primary purpose is to provide for the advancement and preservation of art, music, theater, dance, zoology, botany, natural history or cultural history and whose principal office and majority of activities are conducted within the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District (SCFD); and

WHEREAS, Arapahoe Philharmonic Orchestra, Augustana Arts, Inc., Ballet Ariel, Ballet Nouveau Colorado, Baroque Chamber Orchestra of Colorado, Boulder Ballet, Boulder Museum of Contemporary Art, Boulder Philharmonic Orchestra, Cherokee Ranch and Castle Foundation, Christian Youth Theatre Denver, Colorado Dragon Boat Festival, Colorado Honor Band Association, Colorado Wind Ensemble Inc., Denver Audubon Society, Denver Brass Inc., Denver Concert Band, Denver Municipal Band, Friends of Dinosaur Ridge, Golden Eagle Concert Band, HawkQuest, Highlands Ranch Concert Band, Highlands Ranch Cultural Affairs Association, Junior Symphony Guild Inc., Kantorei, Lamb Spring Archeological Preserve, Lone Tree Symphony Orchestra, Museo de las Americas, Parker Arts Council, Parker Arts Commission, Plains Conservation Center, Rocky Mountain Brassworks, Roxborough Arts Council, South Suburban Community Orchestra, South Suburban Parks and Recreation - Culture and Enrichment Division, St. Andrew Society of Colorado, Su Teatro, Inc., The Denver Brass Inc., The Spirituals Project, The Tesoro Foundation, Think 360 Arts Complete Education, Thorne Ecological Institute, Up Close and Musical, and Young Voices of Colorado meet the eligibility criteria for funding under the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District Act; and

WHEREAS, public testimony was taken on May 10, May 15, May 17 and May 19, 2014 by the Douglas County Cultural Council regarding funding recommendations for *Scientific and Cultural Facilities Act* funds; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Colorado, that *Scientific and Cultural Facilities District Act* sales tax revenues in the amount of \$483,687.72, for Douglas County be distributed as follows:
