Public Notice No. CO-6-2015

This notice states that the CDPHE intends to issue, deny, modify, revoke and reissue, terminate or reissue, Colorado Discharge Permit System permits, pursuant to the Clean Water Act, and the Colorado Water Quality Control Act. All permits are subject to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) review. WQCD has made tentative determinations in conjunction with EPA that limitations and conditions imposed in these permits implement all applicable statutes and regulations and water-quality standards. Written comments or written requests for a public meeting on the tentative determination are to be submitted to WQCD by July 13, 2015. Also, written comments must be received by this date from any person who believes the proposed actions have the potential to cause material injury to a water right. This agreement will resolve civil penalties for alleged violations of the Colorado Water Quality Control Act, which were identified during a March 9, 2015 inspection of 4390 Tennyson Street, LLC's construction site in Denver County. Purpose of Public Notice: To solicit public comment on the proposed Compliance Order on Consent between the Division and the Town of Antonito. This agreement resolves the Town's violations of the Colorado Water Quality Control Act identified in the Notice of Violation issued to the Town on August 30, 2013 and the Town's violations of the Colorado Primary Drinking Water Regulations as identified in the Enforcement Order issued to the Town on October 8, 2013. The Town of Antonito operates a publically owned treatment works (CDPS No. CO0040975) and a drinking water system (PWSID No. CO0111100) in Conejos County.
