**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO, that the First Amendment to the Intergovernmental Agreement by and between the Town and the County, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of Douglas County.

## FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF PARKER AND THE DOUGLAS COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS REGARDING COST SHARING FOR THE 2015 CONCRETE GRINDING CONTRACT, DOUGLAS COUNTY PROJECT NUMBER CI 2015 - 005

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into this May of October, 2015, by and between the Town of Parker, Colorado, a Colorado home rule municipality (the "Town"), and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Colorado (the "County"), hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties."

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on March 24, 2015, the Town and the County entered into an intergovernmental agreement regarding cost sharing for the 2015 Concrete Grinding Contract, Douglas County Project Number CI 2015–005 in 2015 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the Town and the County desire to amend Section 2 of the Agreement to extend the completion date of the project described in the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the sufficiency of which is mutually acknowledged, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. Section 2 of the Agreement is amended to provide as follows:
- 2. <u>Project Improvements</u>. Upon receiving the funds set forth in Section 1 from the Town, the County plans to construct and pay all costs associated with the Project, including the Town's Portion, as described in **Exhibit** A. The County shall complete the Project prior to December 31, 2016. After construction is complete, the Town shall own and maintain the Town's Portion, and the County shall own and maintain the portions of the Project located in unincorporated Douglas County.
- 2. The Town and the County acknowledge and agree that the Agreement has not been amended, except as provided in this First Amendment.
