**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS  
COUNTY, COLORADO TO UPDATE THE DOUGLAS COUNTY  
LOCAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, Douglas County and its incorporated communities are exposed to flooding, wildfire, severe weather, and other natural hazards that increase the vulnerability to life, property, environment and the County's economy; and

**WHEREAS**, hazard mitigation planning will create an operational framework for reducing losses from these hazards; and

**WHEREAS**, hazard mitigation planning is a requirement of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000), 42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq., and continued eligibility for certain sources of federal mitigation funding programs that support loss reduction activities; and

**WHEREAS**, Douglas County has updated its Douglas County Local Hazard Mitigation Plan, in accordance with FEMA's DMA 2000 requirements to remain eligible for future federal disaster funding; and

**WHEREAS**, Douglas County and its flood-prone incorporated communities participate in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP); and

**WHEREAS**, the Colorado Division of Emergency Management and Federal Emergency Management Agency, Region VIII, officials have reviewed the 2014 Douglas County Hazard Mitigation Plan and have approved it as meeting the requirements of the DMA 2000 and 44 C.F.R. §201.6 for a local hazard mitigation plan.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Colorado that Douglas County hereby adopts the Douglas County Hazard Mitigation Plan as the multi-hazard mitigation plan for Douglas County, Colorado.
