NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas (the County"), and The National Weather Service, ("NWS"), agree that achieving StormReady status is desirable;

WHEREAS, the County understands the threat and consequences of severe weather on the citizens of Douglas County;

WHEREAS, the County agrees, through the Office of Emergency Management, to continue its efforts to monitor the weather, respond to the effects of severe weather in conjunction with other responder agencies, alert citizens, provide education to citizens and responders, and mitigate the effects of weather impacts where possible;

WHEREAS, the County accepts the StormReady designation from National Weather Service as recognition of our efforts to prepare the citizens of Douglas County for severe weather events;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO, accepts the StormReady designation between the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas and the National Weather Service, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of Douglas County.
