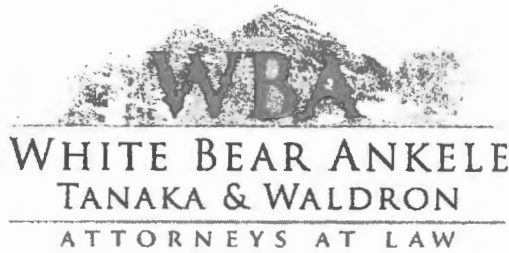

WHEREAS, on November 9, 2010, pursuant to § 32-1-104(3)(a), C.R.S., the Board of Directors for the District (the "Board") adopted a resolution that declared and affirmed the qualifications of the District for inactive status as that term is defined in § 32-1-103(9.3), C.R.S., and

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 32-1-104(3)(b), C.R.S., the Board has now determined that the District shall return to active status.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:







- the district court having jurisdiction over the formation of the special district;
- the Office of the State Auditor; and
