**THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, COLORADO**

**A RESOLUTION REVISING THE LOCAL
EMERGENCY PLANNING COMMITTEE FOR DOUGLAS COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the federal “Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act”, 42 U. S. C. sec 11001 et seq., Title III of the Federal “Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986,” P.L. 99-499 (hereinafter “SARA Title III”), calls for the establishment of a state emergency response commission and local emergency planning committees. The purpose of the local emergency planning committee is to assist in the development of hazardous material release-related emergency response plans, mitigation, and preparedness; certain facility reporting; and notification regarding the listing or release of specified hazardous substances; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado General Assembly implemented SARA Title III through the enactment of Part 15 of Article 33.5 of Title 24, C.R.S. (hereinafter “State Act”), which establishes the Colorado Emergency Planning Commission and provides for the creation and operation of local emergency planning committees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners entered into the Regional Hazardous Materials Board of Arapahoe/Douglas Counties (RHMBADC) Intergovernmental Agreement for reciprocal hazardous material incidents. The RHMBADC Operational and Planning Members shall jointly constitute a subcommittee with the authority and responsibility to function as the LEPC for Arapahoe and Douglas Counties pursuant to the EPCRA and Section 24-32-2604, C. R. S. Specific LEPC functions required of the subcommittee shall be enumerated in the Bylaws.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY, COLORADO:

The Regional Hazardous Materials Board of the Arapahoe/Douglas Counties IGA designates a subcommittee as the authority and responsibility to function as a single LEPC representing Arapahoe County and Douglas County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. R997-069, adopted on June 17, 1997 is hereby rescinded.
