## A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TOWN OF LARKSPUR'S REQUEST FOR MUNICIPAL SHAREBACK OF OPEN SPACE FUNDS

WHEREAS, the voters of Douglas County approved a countywide sales and use tax for the preservation of open space lands and for the provision of trails and parks in Douglas County; and

WHEREAS, the sales and use tax enabling resolution (Douglas County Resolution R- 994-062) provides for a portion of the net proceeds from the tax be attributable to each municipality located within Douglas County, and these funds are referred to as the "municipal shareback"; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur is a municipality within Douglas County and is eligible to receive the above-mentioned municipal shareback; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Larkspur has requested \$19,200 of its municipal shareback toward construction of the Frink Creamery Trailhead and the Colorado Front Range Trail, consistent with the enabling resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Open Space Advisory Committee is recommending, through Resolution 17-02, that the Board of County Commissioners approve the Town of Larkspur's request.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Colorado, that the Town of Larkspur's request for \$19,200 of its accumulated municipal shareback is hereby approved.
