RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH EL
PASO COUNTY FOR DISASTER MUTUAL AID.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas ("Douglas County"), and El Paso County, Colorado desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement to facilitate the support of emergency management efforts through sharing of resources including both personnel and equipment during declared emergencies or disasters.

WHEREAS, the County is willing to enter into such an agreement with El Paso County in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the intergovernmental agreement attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, governmental entities are authorized to enter into intergovernmental agreements pursuant to the provisions of Article XIV, Section 18(2)(a) of the Colorado Constitution, and section 29-1-203, C.R.S.; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO, that the intergovernmental agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas and El Paso County, Colorado; a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of Douglas County.
