WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Colorado, hereby recognizes that December 15, 1941 was declared "Bill of Rights" Day by President Franklin D. Roosevelt; and

WHEREAS, from time to time, most recently on December 15, 2014 Americans have Celebrated "Bill of Rights" Day by Presidential Proclamation; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to express its recognition of and celebrate the importance of the rights and freedoms that all U.S. Citizens have under the Constitution of the United States and in particular the Bill of Rights; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Constitution and Bill of Rights recognizes, affirms and protects the fundamental civil rights of all citizens of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights outlines the freedoms and the principles of representative government that are as strong today as they were when the U.S. Constitution was signed in 1787; and

WHEREAS, the rights and freedoms guaranteed by the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights deserve perennial celebrations in order to recognize the sacrifices made to protect the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Colorado, that we honor and celebrate the importance of the freedoms and rights provided to all citizens by the U.S. Constitution and in particular the Bill of Rights.
