# THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, COLORADO

RESOLUTION APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF JEFFERSON, AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO, REGARDING FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION FOR THE DECKER BRIDGE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Jefferson (Jeffco) and the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas (Dougco), desire to enter into an intergovernmental agreement regarding funding for the Decker Bridge Project; and

**WHEREAS**, Dougco is willing to enter into such an agreement with the Jeffco in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the intergovernmental agreement attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, governmental entities are authorized to enter into intergovernmental agreements pursuant to the provisions of Article XIV, Section 18(2)(a) of the Colorado Constitution, and section 29-1-203, C.R.S.; now, therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED**, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO, that the intergovernmental agreement between the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas and the Jeffco, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is hereby approved, and the Chair of the Board is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of Douglas County.

# INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF JEFFERSON AND THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO, REGARDING FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION FOR THE DECKER BRIDGE PROJECT

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made
and entered into this 18th day of December, 2018 by and between the Board
of County Commissioners of Jefferson County, State of Colorado, a body politic and
corporate ("Jeffco"), and the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, State
of Colorado, a body politic and corporate ("Dougco"), hereinafter collectively referred to
as the "Parties."

#### RECITALS

- A. Jeffco desires to make certain transportation improvements to the bridge over the South Platte River near the town of Decker, Colorado along Colorado Road 67 (the "Decker Bridge Project").
- B. Jeffco has completed the design and other analysis in preparation for the Decker Bridge Project, and Jeffco started roadway construction in July of 2018. Jeffco's contractor, Edge Contracting, Inc. ("Contractor"), anticipates completing construction of the Decker Bridge Project on or about October 31, 2018.
- C. The proposed improvements to the Decker Bridge will occur in both Jefferson County and Douglas County as the South Platte River under the bridge represents the county boundary between the two jurisdictions.
- D. In connection with the Decker Bridge Project, Dougco desires to voluntarily contribute funds to pay for a portion of the Decker Bridge Project.
- E. The Parties are legally empowered under Section 29-1-201, et seq., C.R.S. to enter into this Agreement.
- F. Dougco and Jeffco desire to enter into this Agreement to memorialize the agreements relating to the funding of the Decker Bridge Project.

### **AGREEMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the sufficiency of which are mutually acknowledged, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

1. <u>Acknowledgment and Incorporation of Recitals</u>. The foregoing recitals are hereby acknowledged by the Parties to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Agreement.

2. <u>Term.</u> This Agreement shall commence upon execution by both Parties and shall continue until twelve (12) months following completion of construction of the Decker Bridge Project.

- Jeffco is responsible for managing the design and construction of the Decker Bridge Project. Jeffco has entered into a contract for construction of the Decker Bridge Project (the "Construction Contract") which shall be built in accordance with the construction plans (the "Plans") for the following:
  - a. The South Platte River Bridge Rehabilitation Structure No. E-5-2A, dated September 19, 2017 by the Jefferson County Transportation & Engineering Division., attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by this reference.

Dougco reviewed the Plans for the Decker Bridge Project and concurs with Jeffco's decision to award a construction contract.

- 4. <u>The Construction Contract</u>. Jeffco awarded the Construction Contract in accordance with Jeffco's policies for competitive bidding and Jeffco is responsible for administering the Construction Contract. Dougco agrees to allow the Contractor to carry out the necessary work within Dougco's right-of-way in accordance with the Construction Contract and Plans. Jeffco shall be responsible for holding the Contractor responsible to carry out the work in accordance with the Construction Contract and Plans.
- 5. <u>Douglas County Contribution</u>. The Contractor bid of Five Hundred Fourteen Thousand, Three Hundred Eighty Dollars and No Cents (\$514,380), hereinafter is referred to as the "**Project Cost Estimate**," for the construction of the Decker Bridge Project in accordance with the Contractor's Bid Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit B** and incorporated herein by this reference.

Dougco agrees to voluntarily pay Jeffco a one-time lump sum amount of Two Hundred Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$255,000.00), hereinafter referred to as the "Dougco Contribution" which shall be used for the sole purpose of contributing to the construction of the Decker Bridge Project. In no event will Dougco be liable for paying Jeffco any amount more than the Dougco Contribution, including for any unforeseen project costs or claims.

Following the execution of this Agreement, Dougco Contribution is payable to Jeffco within thirty (30) days after Jeffco has provided Dougco with a written invoice stating the work has been substantially completed in accordance with the Construction Contract and Plans; and Jeffco shall provide Dougco with a copy of the most recent Contractor monthly progress payment.

Jeffco invoice may be sent directly to Art Griffith via email at agriffit@douglas.co.us in lieu of mailing the invoice to the Dougco Public Works Engineering Director.

- 6. <u>Dougco's Contact with the Contractor.</u> Dougco, at its sole discretion, may conduct field inspections within its own right-of-way but Dougco shall not direct, supervise, communicate with or otherwise control the Contractor. If Dougco observes any work or materials that are not being performed in accordance with, or which do not conform with, the Construction Contract and Plans, Dougco shall notify the Jeffco Representative, who shall bring the matter to the attention of the Contractor and ensure the Contractor fixes any discrepancies. Notwithstanding the above, Dougco may meet with the Contractor provided that the Jeffco Representative or designee is also present at such meetings. The Parties acknowledge, that all formal direction, supervision and control of the Contractor remains exclusively with Jeffco.
- 7. <u>Contractor Payments and Change Orders.</u> Jeffco shall be responsible for making all payments to the Contractor and for issuing change orders regarding the Decker Bridge Project. Jeffco shall have total discretion to issue change order(s) for work within Jeffco and Dougco's right of way.
- 8. <u>Time of Performance</u>. Upon execution of this Agreement by both Parties, Jeffco shall diligently pursue construction of the Decker Bridge Project. Jeffco anticipates that the Decker Bridge Project will be substantially completed and open to traffic on or about October 31, 2018.
- 9. <u>Completion of the Decker Bridge Project</u>. Jeffco will notify Dougco once the Contractor has notified Jeffco that construction of the Decker Bridge Project is substantially complete. Dougco has the right to inspect the work; and said inspections shall be conducted with the Jeffco Representative at a time mutually agreeable to the Parties. Absent Dougco's written consent, Jeffco agrees that it shall not accept any work that does not substantially conform to the Construction Contract and Plans.
- 10. <u>Authorized Representatives</u>. Jeffco designates Mike Vanatta, P.E., the Assistant Director/Pre-Construction Engineer of the Transportation & Engineering Division as the Jeffco Representative under this Agreement. Dougco designates Arthur E. Griffith, P.E., the Capital Improvements Manager of the Douglas County Public Works as the Dougco Representative under this Agreement. Each party shall be notified of any change by the other in its authorized representatives.
- 11. <u>Remedies</u>. Dougco shall release Jeffco, its agents and employees from all liability, claims or demands arising from the design and construction of the Decker Bridge Project. The Parties hereto acknowledge and agree that each Party may exercise all rights and remedies in law or in equity, by a decree in specific performance, or such other legal or equitable relief as may be available. This Section shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

12. <u>Notice</u>. Any notice required or permitted by this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been sufficiently given for all purposes if sent by certified mail or registered mail, postage and fees prepaid, addressed to the Party to whom such notice is to be given, at the address set forth below, or at such other address as has been previously furnished in writing, to the other Party. Such notice shall be deemed to have been given when deposited in the United States mail.

- 13. <u>Appropriation</u>. Pursuant to section 29-1-110, C.R.S., any financial obligations of Dougco and Jeffco contained herein that are payable after the current fiscal year are contingent upon funds for that purpose being appropriated, budgeted and otherwise made available on an annual basis.
- 14. <u>Additional Documents</u>. The Parties agree to execute any additional documents or take any additional action that is necessary to carry out the intent of this Agreement.
- 15. <u>Colorado Law</u>. The laws of the State of Colorado shall govern this Agreement. Venue for any action hereunder shall be in the District Court, County of

Jefferson, State of Colorado and the Parties waive any right to remove any action to any other court, whether state or federal.

- 16. <u>Separate Entities</u>. The Parties enter into this Agreement as separate, independent governmental entities and shall maintain such status throughout.
- 17. No Third Party Beneficiaries. The enforcement of the terms and conditions of this Agreement and all rights of action relating to such enforcement, shall be strictly reserved to the Parties, and nothing contained in this Agreement shall give or allow any such claim or right of action by any other or third person under such Agreement. Any beneficiary of the terms and conditions of this Agreement are not intended beneficiaries but are incidental beneficiaries only.
- 18. <u>No Waiver of Governmental Immunity Act</u>. The Parties hereto understand and agree that the Parties, its commissioners, officials, officers, directors, agents and employees, are relying on, and do not waive or intend to waive by any provisions of this Agreement, the monetary limitations or any other rights, immunities and protections provided by the Colorado Governmental Immunity Act, sections 24-10-101 to 120, C.R.S., or otherwise available to the Parties.
- 19. <u>Entirety</u>. This Agreement merges and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations and agreements between the Parties hereto relating to the subject matter hereof and constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties concerning the subject matter hereof.
- 20. <u>Execution by Counterparts: Electronic Signatures</u>. This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall constitute one and the same instrument. The Parties approve the use of electronic signatures for execution of this Agreement. All use of electronic signatures shall be governed by the Uniform Electronic Transactions Act, C.R.S. §§24-71.3-101 to -121.



#### GENERAL NOTES

- ALL WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COLORADO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (COOT) STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROAD AND BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION - 2017, EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY THESE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.
- ALL WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN A MANNER THAT PREVENTS ANY CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS, DEBRIS OR LIQUIDS OF ANY KIND FROM ENTERING THE SOUTH PIATTE RIVER. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PREPARE A WRITTEN PLAN TO ACHIEVE THIS AND SHALL SUBMIT IT TO THE ENGINEER FOR REVIEW. NO WORK SHALL TAKE PLACE UNTIL THE ENGINEER HAS REVIEWED AND ACCEPTED THE CONTRACTOR'S PLAN.
  RECARDLESS OF THE ENGINEER'S REVIEW AND ACCEPTANCE OF THIS PLAN, IT SHALL REVAIN THE CONTRACTOR'S RESPONSIBILITY TO PREVENT ANY MATERIALS FROM REVAIR THE CONTROLLORS RESPONSIBILITY TO PREVENT ANY MAINTAINS FROM ENTERING THE RIVER. IF ANY MATERIALS ENTER THE RIVER, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL CEASE ALL OPERATIONS DIMEDIATELY, NOTIFY THE ENCINEER AND TAKE WHATEVER STEPS ARE RECESSARY TO MITGATE THE ISSUE THE CONTRACTOR SHALL REVISE THE PLAN TO PREVENT ANY MATERIALS FROM ENTERING THE RIVER IN THE FUTURE. THE PLANS THALL BE SUBMITTED IN WAITING TO THE ENGINEER AND NO WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED UNTIL THE REVISED PLAN HAS BEEN REVIEWED AND ACCEPTED BY THE ENUMIFER. ACCEPTED BY THE ENGINEER.
- STEEL DECKING PLANKS SHALL BE FABRICATED OF STEEL IN ACCORDANCE WITH ASTM A653, WITH A MINIMUM YIELD POINT OF 50 KSI AND SHALL BE CALVANIZED.
- STEEL DECK PLANKS SHALL BE FORMED OF 7 GAUGE STEEL WITH A CORRUGATION DEPTH OF 4%" AND SHALL HAVE A MINIMUM SECTION MODULUS OF 4.34 RN3 PER 12" COVER WIDTH,
- ALL OTHER DECK STEEL, INCLUDING SIDE DAMS, END DAMS AND SLIDING PLATES, SHALL BE FABRICATED OF STEEL IN ACCORDANCE WITH ASTM AST A AB OR BETTER. ALL SUCH STEEL SHALL BE HOT DIP GALVANIZED, AFTER FABRICATION, IN ACCORDANCE
- EVERY STEEL DECK PLANK SHALL BE WELDED TO EVERY CIRDER FLANCE WITH A 3/16" FILLET WELD 3" LONG. IN ADDITION, ADJACENT STEEL DECK PLANKS SHALL BE WELDED TO EACH OTHER WITH 3/16" FILLET WELDS 3" LONG, AT THE MIDPOINT
- SIDE AND CENTER DAMS SHALL BE WELDED TO THE PEAKS AND TROUGHS OF THE DECK PLANK CORRUCATIONS, THESE WELDS SHALL BE 5/16" FILLET WELDS AND SHALL EXTEND THE FULL WEDTH OF THE PEAK OR TROUGH.
- END DAWS SHALL BE WELDED TO DECK PLANKS WITH CONTINUOUS FILLET WELDS.
- ALL WELD AFFECTED AREAS SHALL BE TOUCHED UP USING ZINC-RICH PAINT WITH A MINIMUM ZINC CONTENT OF 90% BY WEIGHT.
- 10 ALL UNWELDED SEAMS IN ADJACENT DECK PLANKS AND AT THE INTERFACES BETWEEN DECK PLANKS AND END, SIDE AND CENTER DAMS, SHALL BE SEALED WITH AN APPROVED SEALANT PRIOR TO PLACING FLOWFILL.
- 11, FLOW-FILL SHALL BE STRUCTURE BACKFILL (FLOW-FBL) IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 208 OF THE COOT STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND AS MODIFIED BY THE PROJECT SPECIAL PROVISIONS. THE 28 DAY STRENGTH SHALL BE

- 14 THE CONTRACTOR IS ADVISED THAT THE EXISTING PAINT ON THE STEEL GIRDERS WAS TESTED FOR LEAD AND FOUND TO CONTAIN ONLY TRACES OF LEAD (0.045%, BY WEIGHT). THE PAINT IS THEREFORE NOT CONSIDERED LEAD BASED PAINT. THE CONTRACTOR IS, HOWEVER, RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING WORKER PROTECTION TO COMPLY WITH OSHA REQUIREMENTS...
- 15. THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OR WORK WILL BE SUPPLIED, INSTALLED OR PERFORMED BY JEFFERSON COUNTY AS NOTED BELOW:

  - 15 1. MILING OF EXISTING ASPHALT OVERLAY TO WITHIN APPROXIMATELY 1"OF THE EXISTING CORRUCATED STEEL DECKING BY JEFFERSON COUNTY.

    15.2. ASPHALT OVERLAY PAYING BY JEFFERSON COUNTY.

    15.3. SUPPLY NEW NEOPPERE BEARING PADS BY JEFFERSON COUNTY. TO BE INSTALLED BY THE CONTRACTOR.

    15.4 SUPPLY CORRUCATED STEEL DECK PLANKS, EDGE PLATES, END PLATES AND SLIDING PLATES BY JEFFERSON COUNTY. TO BE INSTALLED BY THE CONTRACTOR.
- 15.5. VARIABLE MESSAGE SIGNS TO BE PROVIDED AND PLACED BY JEFFERSON
- COUNTY.

  THE CONTRACTOR SHALL COORDINATE CLOSELY WITH JEFFERSON COUNTY FOR ALL TEUS TO BE SUPPLIED OR WORK TO BE PERFORMED BY JEFFERSON COUNTY. A MINIMUM OF ONE WEEK NOTICE IS REQUIRED FOR EACH ITEM TO BE SUPPLIED OR WORK TO BE PERFORMED BY JEFFERSON COUNTY.

#### CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE AND PHASING

- 1. CLEAN AND PAINT ALL GIRDER ENDS AT BOTH ABUTMENTS
- 2 THE CONCRETE DIAPHRADMS AT BOTH ABUTMENTS SHALL CONSTRUCTED FULL WIDTH AT BOTH ABUTMENTS BEFORE WORK ON THE DECK IS STARTED. THE DIAPHRADMS SHALLS CONSTRUCTED WHILE MAINTAINED A MINIMUM OF ONE LANG OF ALTERNATING DIRECTION TRAFFIC AT ALL TIMES DURING WORKING HOURS, DURING NON-WORK HOURS, THE DIAPHRADM CONSTRUCTION AREAS SHALL BE COVERED WITH STEEL PLATES TO PROTECT WORK IN PROGRESS AND THE FULL WIDTH OF THE BRIDGE SHALL REMAIN OPEN TO TRAFFE
- 3. AFTER COMPLETION OF THE DIAPHRAGMS, THE DECK REMOVAL AND REPLACEMENT CAN BE INITIATED. THIS WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED IN PHASES, MAINTAINING ONE LANE OF ALTERNATING DIRECTION TRAFFIC AT ALL THAS, INCLUDING WORKING AND NON-WORKING HOURS. THE NEW CORRUGATED DECKING SHALL BE INSTALLED FOLLOWED BY THE FILLING OF FLUTES WITH FLOW-FILL, APPLYING MEMBRANE WATERPROPORTING THEN THE HIM.
- THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OF WORK CAN BE PERFORMED AT ANY TIME AS LONG AS A MINIMUM OF A SINGLE LANE OF ALTERNATING DIRECTION OF TRAFFIC IS MAINTAINED.
- . TRIMMING OF ENDS OF STEEL GIRDERS AT THE CENTER PIER.
- 6-SEARING REPLACEMENT AT CENTER PIER.
- C CLEANING AND PAINTING OF FASCIA CIRDERS AND ENDS AT CENTER PIER
