RESOLUTION MAKING APPOINTMENTS TO THE DOUGLAS COUNTY NOXIOUS
WEED ADVISORY COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Noxious Weed Advisory Commission was established by the Board of County Commissioners in accordance with Resolution No. R-991-009 and C.R.S. § 35-5.5-107, to act solely in an advisory capacity to the Board of County Commissioners in matters pertaining to undesirable plant management; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Colorado desires to make appointments to the Douglas County Noxious Weed Advisory Commission; now, therefore,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to C.R.S. § 35-5.5-107(1), the governing body of each county and municipality shall appoint a local advisory board. The local governing body, at its sole option, may appoint itself, or a commission of landowners, to act as the local advisory board for that jurisdiction. The members of each local advisory board shall be residents of the unincorporated portion of the county or residents of the municipality, as the case may be, and in the case of a county, at least a majority of the members of the local advisory board shall be landowners of over forty acres.
