A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)
TRANSITION PLAN FOR PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS, the Federal government enacted the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA) to prevent discrimination of the physically and mentally disabled relating to employment and access to public facilities; and

WHEREAS, Title II of the ADA requires the development and adoption of a Transition Plan to document physical barriers to accessibility, proposed structural modifications to remove those barriers, and a proposed time schedule for the completion of all required modifications; and

WHEREAS, on April 09, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas adopted Resolution No. R-019-044 pertaining to ADA Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities in the Public Right-of-Way (PROWAG); and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas remain committed to the ADA and the elimination of physical barriers to accessibility in the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, a Transition Plan for the transportation network has been prepared and reflects infrastructure and ADA design standards, referred to as the "ADA Transition Plan for Public Right-of-Way"; in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO**, that Douglas County hereby approves the ADA Transition Plan for Public Right-of-Way, as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein.
