A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE ADOPTION OF REVISIONS TO THE
DOUGLAS COUNTY STORM DRAINAGE DESIGN AND TECHNICAL CRITERIA
MANUAL**

WHEREAS, the purpose of drainage standards and specifications is to provide for the planning, design and construction of improvements to new or existing storm drainage facilities; and

WHEREAS, the failure of such planning, design, and construction to conform to uniform standards, specifications, and procedures may be detrimental to and may endanger the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, at a public hearing held on July 8, 2008, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") adopted the Storm Drainage Design and Technical Criteria Manual, which contains considerable data, requirements, procedures and technical information; and

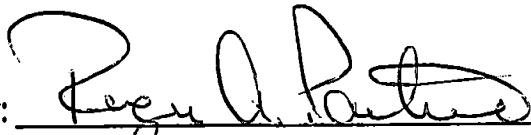
WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend the Storm Drainage Design and Technical Criteria Manual adopted in 2008 to comply with State changes to the Colorado Discharge Permit System (CDPS) General Permit, Permit No. COR090000 and CDPS General Permit No. COR080000, *Stormwater Discharges Associated with Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s)*; now, therefore,

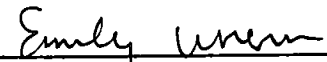
BE IT RESOLVED, that the **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO**, hereby authorizes the approval and adoption of the revisions to the Douglas County Storm Drainage and Technical Criteria Manual as presented, which shall entirely replace Chapter 14, Stormwater Quality, of the Storm Drainage Design and Technical Criteria Manual adopted in 2008.

FURTHER, BE IT RESOLVED, that said amendment becomes effective on July 1, 2019.
