A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE DOUGLAS COUNTY CULTURAL COUNCIL'S RECOMMENDATION FOR SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL FACILITIES DISTRICT TIER III FUNDING FOR 2019-2020

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Cultural Council was appointed by the Board of County Commissioners to determine the distribution of Tier III sales tax proceeds as provided for in the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District Act; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the Douglas County Cultural Council are (1) to direct resources to qualifying organizations which are accessible to, and whose scientific and cultural services benefit, residents of Douglas County; and (2) to promote long-term development and diversity of the scientific and cultural resources available to residents of Douglas County; and

WHEREAS, proceeds are required by statute to be distributed to organizations qualified as not-for-profit under IRC Section 501(c)(3), or agencies of local government whose primary purpose is to provide for the advancement and preservation of art, music, theater, dance, zoology, botany, natural history or cultural history and whose principal office and majority of activities are conducted within the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District (SCFD); and

WHEREAS, public testimony was taken on April 9, 16, 23, 30, May 7 and 14, and June 11 by the Douglas County Cultural Council regarding funding recommendations for *Scientific and Cultural Facilities Act* funds; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, Colorado, that *Scientific and Cultural Facilities District Act* sales tax revenues in the amount of \$850,436.32, for Douglas County be distributed as follows:
