In compliance with the provisions of Colorado Revised Statute 1-5-205(1) notice is hereby given that a Presidential Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Ballots will be mailed to all eligible electors beginning the week of February 10, 2020. Voters who do not receive a ballot by February 17, 2020 may request a ballot from the Douglas County Elections Office, located at 125 Stephanie Place, Castle Rock, CO 80109, or by calling 303-660-7444.

Completed ballots may be returned by U.S. Mail or hand delivered to a Douglas County **BALLOT DROP BOX LOCATION** or **VOTER SERVICE AND POLLING CENTER**. If you choose to return a completed ballot by mail, you must affix adequate postage to the **OFFICIAL BALLOT RETURN ENVELOPE** before mailing. Ballots must be received by the Douglas County Elections Office no later than 7:00 p.m. on March 3, 2020. Postmarks do not count as a received date.
