## THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO

A RESOLUTION RESTATING AND APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR A RECIPROCAL AMBULANCE LICENSING AND INSPECTION PROGRAM BY AND AMONG THE COLORADO COUNTIES OF ADAMS, ARAPAHOE, BOULDER, DOUGLAS, ELBERT, JEFFERSON AND THE CITY AND COUNTY OF BROOMFIELD

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the State of Colorado enacted the Colorado Emergency Medical Services Act, Section 25-3.5-101, et seq., C.R.S., that states "no person shall provide ambulance service publicly or privately in the State of Colorado unless that person holds a valid license to do so issued by the Board of County Commissioners or designee, on an annual basis, of the Colorado county in which the ambulance service is based, subject to certain exceptions as provided for in the EMS act," and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Regulation 6 CCR 1015-3, as amended and adopted by the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, each ambulance service is required to obtain a license, on an annual basis, in each Colorado county from which it transports patients, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article XIV, Section 18 of the Colorado Constitution and C.R.S. 29-1-203, et seq., as amended, Colorado counties may cooperate and contract with one another to provide any lawful governmental function or service, and

**WHEREAS**, the participating Colorado counties wish to amend and restate the joint ambulance licensing and inspection program based upon rule changes to 6CCR 1015-3 made by the Department of Public Health and Environment effective January 1, 2019.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Colorado, that the Intergovernmental Agreement between Douglas County and the other participating entities, a copy of which is attached, is hereby approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, this Resolution and IGA supersede all previous Ambulance Inspection and Licensing Resolutions and IGAs.
