**RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION R-991-009 ESTABLISHING THE
UNDESIREABLE PLANT MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION PURSUANT
TO THE COLORADO NOXIOUS WEED ACT.**

WHEREAS, the Colorado Noxious Weed Act, §35-5.5-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S. (the "Act"), requires local government to develop a Noxious Weed Management Plan for the purpose of managing noxious weeds on public and private properties and to review such plan at least every three years; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Act and specifically C.R.S. §35-5.5-107(1) the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board" or the "County") adopted Resolution R-991-009 establishing the Douglas County Undesirable Plant Management Advisory Commission now referred to as the Douglas County Weed Advisory Commission (the Commission); and

WHEREAS, the number of appointees to the Commission has changed from time to time and currently consists of nine (9) members; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to amend the number of members for the Commission to seven (7) moving forward to ensure adequate participation on this important issue.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas, State of Colorado, as follows:

Resolution R-991-009 is amended to reflect that the Douglas County Weed Advisory Commission shall consist of seven members meeting all statutory criteria.
