**RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING SEPTEMBER 29, 2020
AS PHILIP S. MILLER DAY**

WHEREAS, Philip S. Miller made a significant and lasting contribution to Douglas County through his exemplary life as a philanthropist and businessman; and

WHEREAS, Philip S. Miller established a charitable trust on January 5, 1980, exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County is one of nine beneficiaries of said trust, which includes the Children's Hospital of Denver, Shriners Hospitals for Crippled Children, Town of Castle Rock, Douglas County Library, Castle Rock Fire Department, Douglas County 4-H Council, Douglas County Fair Association and Douglas County High School; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County has chosen to primarily use the annual trust allocation to increase needed services in the community through a competitive grant application process; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County has distributed \$7,932,075 to 80 organizations for uses such as emergency assistance, suicide prevention, medical assistance, mental health services and programs that support at-risk school age children and seniors; and

BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO, hereby proclaims September 29, 2020, as Philip S. Miller Day, to honor Mr. Miller's legacy and express sincere appreciation for his meaningful contribution to improving the quality of life throughout Douglas County.
