RESOLUTION FOR A TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF POSTON PARKWAY BETWEEN WILDCAT RESERVE PARKWAY AND GRIGS ROAD, ASSOCIATED WITH THE POSTON PARKWAY RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT, DOUGLAS COUNTY PROJECT NUMBER CI 2020-033.

WHEREAS, Douglas County Public Works is requesting a temporary road closure for Poston Parkway between Wildcat Reserve Parkway and Grigs Road. The closure will allow for the reconstruction of the concrete pavement on Poston Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the "Board") has the authority to temporarily prohibit the operation of vehicles upon roads within its jurisdiction, pursuant to sections 42-4-106(1) and (6), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the temporary road closure of Poston Parkway will be needed for a maximum of approximately 117 days, between June 6, 2022 and September 30, 2022, in three phases, limiting the length of closure of each phase to a maximum length of 48 days for any single phase, when weather allows the completion of the Project on one hundred seventeen consecutive days; and

WHEREAS, Douglas County Public Works will prepare a detour - signage plan prior to the closure of Poston Parkway, generally following the phasing plan shown in Exhibit A, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO**, hereby authorizes the approval of the temporary road closure of Poston Parkway between Wildcat Reserve Parkway and Grigs Road for one hundred seventeen (117) consecutive days between September 29, 2021 and October 29, 2021, when weather allows completion of the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLOVED that a signed detour route, approved warning signs and barricades shall be erected at designated locations, as shown on the attached Exhibit A, prior to the temporary closure authorized herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such warning signs and barricades shall be removed and such road shall be reopened upon expiration of the temporary closure approved herein, or at such earlier time as determined by Douglas County Public Works.
