**RESOLUTION FOR A TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE OF PALMER DIVIDE
AVENUE FROM WHERE THE EXISTING ASPHALT PAVEMENT ENDS EAST OF
THUNDER ROAD TO APPROXIMATELY 2,500 FEET EAST OF BLACK FOREST
ROAD, ASSOCIATED WITH THE PALMER DIVIDE AVENUE PHASE 2
CONSTRUCTION, DOUGLAS COUNTY PROJECT NUMBER CI 2021-043.**

WHEREAS, Douglas County Engineering Division is requesting a temporary road closure for Palmer Divide Avenue from where the existing asphalt pavement ends east of Thunder Road to approximately 2,500 feet east of Black Forest Road. The closure will allow for the installation of new culverts and new asphalt pavement for this section of Palmer Divide Avenue, which is currently a gravel road; and

WHEREAS, Palmer Divide Avenue is a boundary roadway between Douglas And El Paso Counties, and this section of Palmer Divide Avenue is a portion of the road that is maintained and operated by Douglas County as part of an agreement with El Paso County, functioning as a County-maintained roadway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners (the “Board”) has the authority to temporarily prohibit the operation of vehicles upon roads within its jurisdiction, pursuant to sections 42-4-106(1) and (6), C.R.S.; and

WHEREAS, the temporary road closure of Palmer Divide Avenue will be needed for approximately 45 days, between June 6, 2022 and July 21, 2022, and only between the hours of 7 am and 5 pm on each day, when weather allows the completion of the Project on forty-five consecutive days; and

WHEREAS, the Douglas County Engineering Division will prepare a detour - signage plan prior to the closure of Palmer Divide Avenue, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the **BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, STATE OF COLORADO**, hereby authorizes the approval of the temporary road closure of Palmer Divide Avenue from where the existing asphalt pavement ends east of Thunder Road to approximately 2,500 feet east of Black Forest Road for approximately forty-five (45) consecutive days between June 6, 2022 and July 21, 2022, when weather allows completion of the Project.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLOVED that a signed detour route, approved warning signs and barricades shall be erected at designated locations, as shown on the attached Exhibit A, prior to the temporary closure authorized herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such warning signs and barricades shall be removed and such road shall be reopened upon expiration of the temporary closure approved herein, or at such earlier time as determined by Douglas County Engineering Division.


